

LOCAL GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 15, 1943.

An Act to make further provision in relation to the preparation of rolls of citizens in the City of Sydney, and of rolls of electors in municipalities and shires; to make certain provisions in relation to the control and management by councils of abattoirs; for these purposes to amend the Local Government Act, 1919, the Local Government (Electoral Provisions) Act, 1941, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th June, 1943.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Local Government (Amendment) Act, 1943." Short title.

2. (1) The Local Government (Electoral Provisions) Act, 1941, as amended by the Local Government (Amendment) Act, 1942, is amended— Amendment of Act No. 32, 1941.

(a) by omitting from subsection one of section five the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-three" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-four"; Sec. 5.
(Preparation of original roll.)

(b) by omitting from subsection one of section ten the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-three" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-four"; Sec. 10.
(Extension of franchise.)

(c) by omitting from subsection one of section eleven the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-three" wherever occurring and by inserting Sec. 11.
(Commencement of s. 12.)

inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-four";

- (d) by omitting from subsection four of section eleven the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-three" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand nine hundred and forty-four".

Rolls need not be prepared in 1943.

(2) It shall not be necessary for the council of an area to cause an original roll of electors or a supplementary roll of electors to be prepared in the year one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.

Amendment of Act No. 41, 1919.

3. (1) The Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended—

(Establishment of abattoirs.)

- (a) (i) by omitting paragraph (b) of subsection two of section four hundred and sixty-one and by inserting in lieu thereof the following new paragraphs:—

(b) to sell, either on its own behalf or on behalf of any other person, cattle and meat, including bacon, ham, sausages, saveloys, and other smallgoods manufactured or prepared from a carcase or any portion thereof;

(b1) to establish, maintain, conduct and control works for canning, curing and smoking meat;

(b2) to purchase cattle and meat;

- (ii) by omitting from paragraph (e) of the same subsection all words after the words "sell the same";

(Sale of carcases of animals not slaughtered in abattoir.)

- (b) (i) by omitting from subsection one of section four hundred and sixty-four the words "or in the abattoir established under the Act fourteenth Victoria number thirty-six";

- (ii) by inserting at the end of the same subsection the following new subsection:—

(1A) Where abattoirs have been established by a council, or where any council has in conjunction with any other council jointly

may be made prohibiting or regulating the sale or exposure for sale within the area of any such council of sausages, saveloys or other smallgoods (to be used as the food of man) manufactured or prepared from any carcase or part of a carcase of any animal (other than rabbits, poultry and game) which has not been slaughtered in the aforesaid abattoirs or in the abattoirs established under the Meat Industry Act, 1915.

The power conferred by this subsection shall not extend to authorise the making of ordinances prohibiting or regulating the sale or exposure for sale within the area of any such council, of tinned goods.

(c) by omitting sections 464A and 464B.

(2) The Greater Newcastle Act, 1937, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting paragraphs (c) and (d) of section twenty-four.
