

LOCAL GOVERNMENT (ELECTORAL PROVISIONS) AMENDMENT ACT.

Act No. 18, 1944.

An Act to make certain provisions in relation to elections in local government areas; to amend the Local Government Act, 1919, the Local Government (Electoral Provisions) Act, 1941, and certain other Acts; to validate certain matters; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 3rd November, 1944.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Local Government (Electoral Provisions) Amendment Act, 1944."

(2) The Local Government (Electoral Provisions) Act, 1941, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Local Government (Electoral Provisions) Act, 1941-1944.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced upon the first day of August, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four.

- (iii) by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection two of the same section the words “Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act, 1912-1941, on the eighteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act, 1912-1944, on the twenty-fourth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-four”;

- (b) (i) by omitting from subsection one of section eleven the words “one thousand nine hundred and forty-four” wherever occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “one thousand nine hundred and forty-five”;
- (ii) by omitting from subsection four of the same section the words “one thousand nine hundred and forty-four” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “one thousand nine hundred and forty-five”;
- (iii) by inserting at the end of the same section the following new subsection:—

(5) This section shall not apply to the council of an area which has, in the year one thousand nine hundred and forty-four, prepared an original roll of electors which, pursuant

3. Where, before the date of commencement of this Rolls
Act, the council of an area has commenced the prepara- validated.
tion of an original roll of electors pursuant to the pro-
visions of section eleven of the Local Government (Elec-
toral Provisions) Act, 1941, as amended by subsequent
Acts, the preparation of that original roll may be con-
tinued and completed in all respects as if this Act had
not been enacted, and every original roll so prepared and
completed shall be deemed for all purposes to be the
original roll of electors prepared in the year one thousand
nine hundred and forty-four by the council of the area
concerned.
