George VI. An Act to amend the Lotteries and Art Unions
No. 34, 1944. Act, 1901-1929, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 8th December, 1944.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Lotteries and Art Unions (Amendment) Act, 1944."

(2) The Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901-1929, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act may be cited as the Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901-1944.

2. The Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901-1929, as amended by subsequent Acts is amended—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection one of section five after the word "ornament" the words "or of real property";

(b) by inserting at the end of subsection two of the same section the words "or of real property."
