

FORESTRY (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 39, 1946.

An Act to amend the Forestry Act, 1916-1935, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 21st May, 1946.] George VI.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Forestry (Amendment) Act, 1946." Short

(2) The Forestry Act, 1916, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act may be cited as the Forestry Act, 1916-1946.

2. The Forestry Act, 1916, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from section nine the words "Provided that in such administration and in the exercise and discharge of such powers and duties the commission shall be subject to and shall act in accordance with the regulations" and by inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:— Amendment

In the exercise and discharge of the powers, authorities, duties and functions conferred or imposed on the commission by or under this Act or any other Act the commission shall be subject in all respects to the control and direction of the Minister.
