## MORATORIUM (AMENDMENT) ACT.

## Act No. 51, 1946.

An Act to amend the Moratorium Act, 1932-1945, Ceorge VI. in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 24th December, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Moratorium Short title and citation.
- (2) The Moratorium Act, 1932, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Moratorium Act, 1932-1946.
