No. 23, 1947. An Act to amend the Moratorium Act, 1932-1946,
in certain respects; and for purposes
connected therewith. [Assented to, 2nd
December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Moratorium
(Amendment) Act, 1947."

(2) The Moratorium Act, 1932, as amended by
subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the
Moratorium Act, 1932-1947.
