An Act to amend the Physiotherapists Registration Act, 1945-1946, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 9th December, 1947.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Physiotherapists Short title and citation. Registration (Amendment) Act, 1947."
- (2) The Physiotherapists Registration Act, 1945, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Physiotherapists Registration Act, 1945-1947.
- 2. The Physiotherapists Registration Act, 1945-1946, Amendment of Act No. 9, is amended—

(a) by omitting from paragraph (g) of subsection sec. 21. one of section twenty-one the words "being at Qualifications to receivistra." the commencement of this Act" and by inserting tion.) in lieu thereof the words "having been";

- (b) by inserting in the same paragraph after the word "Commonwealth" the words "during the war between His Majesty and Germany and her Allies which commenced on the third day of September, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine";
- (i) by omitting from paragraph (i) of the same subsection the words "being, at the commencement of this Act" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "having been, at any time during the period which commenced on the third day of September, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, and ended on the day on which this Act commenced";
