BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, No. 31, 1948.
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Mine Subsidence (Amendment) Act, 1948." Short title and citation.

(2) The Mine Subsidence Act, 1928, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Mine Subsidence Act, 1928-1948.

2. The Mine Subsidence Act, 1928, is amended:— Amendment of Act No. 53, 1928.

- (a) by omitting from subsection four of section fifteen the word "allowed"; Sec. 15. (Mine Subsidence Insurance Fund.)
- (b) by inserting at the end of the same section the following new subsection:—

(c) Any moneys in the fund which are not immediately required for the purposes of the fund may be invested by the board in any manner in which trustees are for the time being authorised to invest trust funds.

Any interest from time to time accruing from any such investment shall be paid into the fund.
