ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH TRUST PROPERTY (AMENDMENT) ACT.

An Act to amend the Roman Catholic Church Trust Property Act, 1936, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 24th March, 1950.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title, citation and commencement. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Roman Catholic Church Trust Property (Amendment) Act, 1950."

(2) The Roman Catholic Church Trust Property Act, 1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Roman Catholic Church Trust Property Act, 1936-1950.

- (3) This Act shall commence fourteen days after the day upon which the assent of His Majesty to this Act is signified.
- 2. The Roman Catholic Church Trust Property Act, Amendment 1936, is amended by inserting next after section four the No. 24. following new section:—

4A. (1) As from the commencement of the Roman Change of Catholic Church Trust Property (Amendment) Act, name of body 1950:--

Goulburn.

- (a) the corporate name of the body corporate Archdiocese constituted by section four of this Act and under the corporate name of the trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Diocese of Goulburn shall be the trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn;
- (b) a reference in any Act or other instrument to the Diocese of Goulburn or to the trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Diocese of Goulburn shall be read and construed as a reference to the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn or to the trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn, as the case may be.
- (2) Nothing contained in the Roman Catholic Church Trust Property (Amendment) Act, 1950, shall prejudice or affect in any way the continuity of the body corporate referred to in subsection one of this section, but the same shall continue notwithstanding the provisions of the said Act.
- (3) The alteration of name effected by subsection one of this section shall not affect any property, powers, rights, authorities, duties, functions, liabilities or obligations of the body corporate referred to in subsection one of this section. or render defective any legal or other proceedings instituted or to be instituted by or against the said body corporate. Any legal or other proceedings may be continued or commenced by or against the corporation by the name of the trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn that might have been continued or commenced by or against the corporation by the name of the trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Diocese of Goulburn.
