

SALE OF GOODS (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 8, 1953.

An Act to make certain provisions in relation to sales of sheepskins ; for this purpose to amend the Sale of Goods Act, 1923-1937; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 25th September, 1953.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Sale of Goods (Amendment) Act, 1953".

(2) The Sale of Goods Act, 1923, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Sale of Goods Act, 1923-1953.

(3) This Act shall commence on a day to be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

2. The Sale of Goods Act, 1923-1937, is amended by inserting at the end of section sixty-one the following new subsection:—

Draft
allowance on
sheep skins.

(2) Any term, express or implied, in any contract of sale of sheep skins entered into after the commencement of the Sale of Goods (Amendment) Act, 1953, providing that in computing the price of the sheep skins any deduction of the kind commonly known as the draft allowance is to be made from the weight of the sheep skins, shall be void and of no effect.
