

IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 5, 1954.

An Act to amend section 5E of the Irrigation Act, 1912-1949, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th April, 1954.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Irrigation (Amendment) Act, 1954."

(2) The Irrigation Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Irrigation Act, 1912-1954.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced upon the thirteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three.

2. (1) The Irrigation Act, 1912-1949, is amended—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (a) of subsection one of section 5E after the words "the provisions of" the words "subsection one of section 5A of this Act or the provisions of";

(b) by omitting subsection two of the same section.

(2) Where any pension payable under the Superannuation Act, 1916, as amended by subsequent Acts, to an officer, who retired from the service of the Commission under the provisions of subsection one of section 5A of the Irrigation Act, 1912-1949, before the date of commencement of this Act, had not commenced before such date, such pension shall be deemed to have been payable to such officer as from such date.
