An Act to require The Electricity Commission of New South Wales to pay one-half of the subsidies paid in each year by The Electricity Authority of New South Wales; for this and other purposes to amend the Electricity Development Act, 1945, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th March, 1957.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

No. 7, 1957.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Electricity Development (Amendment) Act, 1957".

Short title, citation and commencement.

(2) The Electricity Development Act, 1945, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Electricity Development Act, 1945-1957.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six.

2. The Electricity Development Act, 1945, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended—

Amendment of Act No. 13, 1946.

(a) by omitting section fifteen and by inserting in lieu thereof the following sections:—

Subst. sec. 15 and new sec. 15A. Authority to make and submit annual estimates.

15. The Authority shall in or before the month of May in each year make and submit to the Minister an estimate of the amount to be expended by the Authority during the next following year commencing on the first day of July in defraying the expenses incurred in the administration of this Act and in carrying out the powers, authorities, duties and functions conferred and imposed upon the Authority by or under this Act. Such estimate shall specify the amount to be paid during such next following year in respect of subsidies granted or to be granted under section thirteen of this Act.

15A. The Electricity Commission of New South Wales shall pay to the Colonial Treasurer for credit of the Electricity Development Account an amount equal to one-half of the subsidies granted under section thirteen of this Act and paid by the Authority.

Contribution by Electricity Commission.

Such amount shall be paid by the said Commission in such sum or sums at such time or times and in such manner as the Minister may from time to time by notice to the said Commission require.
