## PUBLIC SERVICE AND OTHER STATUTORY BODIES (EXTENDED LEAVE) ACT.

## Act No. 5, 1959.

Act to amend the provisions relating to long service leave contained in the Public Service (Amendment) Act, 1919, the Irrigation Act, 1912, the Main Roads Act, 1924, the Government Railways Act, 1912, the Transport Act, 1930, and the Police Regulation Act, 1899, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 24th September, 1959.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Service and Other Statutory Bodies (Extended Leave) Act, 1959."

Amendment of Act No. 43, 1919. Sec. 13. (Leave of absence after years of service.)

2. The Public Service (Amendment) Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from subsection one of section thirteen the words "on the completion of twenty years service shall be entitled to a further three months leave on full pay or six months on half pay" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "after completion of further service after fifteen years and up to twenty years shall be entitled to a further proportionate amount of leave on full pay or half pay calculated on the basis of three months or six months respectively for five years service".

(1) The Irrigation Act, 1912, as amended by subse-No. 5, 1959. quent Acts, is amended by omitting from subsection one of section 5c the words "on the completion of twenty years of Act No. service shall be entitled to a further three months leave on full 73, 1912. pay or six months on half pay" and by inserting in lieu Sec. 5c. thereof the words "after completion of further service after (Leave of absence fifteen years and up to twenty years shall be entitled to a after years further proportionate amount of leave on full pay or half of service.) pay calculated on the basis of three months or six months respectively for five years service".

- **4.** (1) The Main Roads Act, 1924, as amended by subse-Amendment quent Acts, is amended by omitting from subsection one of of Act No. 24, 1924. section 7A the words "on the completion of twenty years' Sec. 7A. service shall be entitled to a further three months' leave on (Leave of full pay or six months on half pay" and by inserting in lieu absence after years thereof the words "after completion of further service after of service.) fifteen years and up to twenty years shall be entitled to a further proportionate amount of leave on full pay or half pay calculated on the basis of three months or six months respectively for five years' service".
- (2) The Main Roads Act, 1924, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Main Roads Act, 1924-1959.
- 5. (1) The Government Railways Act, 1912, as amended by Amendment subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from subsection of Act No. 30, 1912. two of section 100A the words "on the completion of twenty Sec. 100A. years service shall be entitled to a further three months leave (Annual on full pay or six months on half pay" and by inserting in leave, extended lieu thereof the words "after completion of further service leave and after fifteen years and up to twenty years shall be entitled retiring leave of turther proportionate amount of leave on full pay or officers.) half pay calculated on the basis of three months or six months respectively for five years service".

(1) The Transport Act, 1930, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from subsection two of section one hundred and twenty-three the words "on the completion of twenty years service shall be entitled to a further three months leave on full pay or six months on half pay" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "after completion of further service after fifteen years and up to twenty years shall be entitled to a further proportionate amount of leave on full pay or half pay calculated on the basis of three months or six months respectively for five years service".
- (2) The Transport Act, 1930, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Transport Act, 1930-1959.

(Leave of absence after years of service.)

- 7. (1) The Police Regulation Act, 1899, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting from subsection one of section 12A the words "on the completion of twenty years service shall be entitled to a further three months leave on full pay or six months on half pay" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "after completion of further service after fifteen years and up to twenty years shall be entitled to a further proportionate amount of leave on full pay or half pay calculated on the basis of three months or six months respectively for five years service".
- (2) The Police Regulation Act, 1899, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Police Regulation Act, 1899-1959.
