

**LOTTERIES AND ART UNIONS (AMENDMENT)
ACT.**

Act No. 13, 1960.

Elizabeth II, No. 13, 1960; An Act relating to the grant of approvals for the formation of voluntary associations under the Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901-1944; for this purpose to amend the said Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 30th March, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Lotteries and Art Unions (Amendment) Act, 1960".

(2) The Lotteries and Art Unions Act 1901, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901-1960.

2. The Lotteries and Art Unions Act, 1901-1944, is amended by inserting next after section six the following new section :—

6A. Any application for or in relation to the formation of a voluntary association referred to in section five of this Act, may, in the absolute discretion of the Governor
or

or the Minister, as the case may require, be granted, ^{No. 13, 1960.} unconditionally or subject to such conditions as may be prescribed or the Governor or the Minister may impose, or refused.

Without limiting the generality of the provisions of this Act in the case of any application for or in relation to the formation of a voluntary association referred to in paragraph (b) of subsection one of section five of this Act such conditions may include a condition restricting or limiting the value of the articles of use or ornament or the real property to be allotted and distributed as referred to in the said paragraph.
