

**FISHERIES AND OYSTER FARMS (AMENDMENT)
ACT.**

Act No. 4, 1960.

Elizabeth II, No. 4, 1960. An Act to make further provisions with respect to the taking of fish in inland waters; for this purpose to amend the Fisheries and Oyster Farms Act, 1935-1957; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 24th March, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Fisheries and Oyster Farms (Amendment) Act, 1960".

(2) The Fisheries and Oyster Farms Act, 1935, as amended by subsequent Acts and by regulations made under subsection three of section one hundred and twenty of the said Act, as so amended, and by this Act, may be cited as the Fisheries and Oyster Farms Act, 1935-1960.
