

## EVANS HEAD HARBOUR WORKS ACT.

### Act No. 44, 1960.

Elizabeth II, An Act to sanction and to provide for the carrying  
No. 44, 1960. out of works for the Evans Head Harbour;  
 to validate certain matters; and for purposes  
 connected therewith. [Assented to, 4th November,  
 1960.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty,  
 by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
 Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in  
 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
 follows :—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Evans Head Harbour  
 Works Act, 1960".

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced upon  
 the first day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty.

Work  
sanctioned.

**2.** (1) (a) The carrying out of the work described in the  
 Schedule to this Act is hereby sanctioned.

(b) The said work shall be deemed to be an  
 authorised work within the meaning of the Public Works Act,  
 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts.

(c) The Minister for Public Works is empowered  
 to carry out the said work and shall be the constructing  
 authority for the same within the meaning of the said Act, as  
 so amended, and shall enter into such contracts and take all  
 such necessary steps for the proper execution thereof as such  
 authority may think proper.

(d) The provisions of the Public Works Act, 1912,  
 as amended by subsequent Acts, sections thirty-four, thirty-  
 five, thirty-six and thirty-seven excepted, shall apply to and  
 in respect of the said work.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection <sup>No. 44, 1960.</sup> one of this section the provisions of section thirty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, shall apply to and in respect of any contracts referred to in paragraph (c) of subsection one of this section.

3. The plan of the said work is the plan marked "Evans <sup>The plan.</sup> Head Harbour Works" signed by the Minister for Public Works and countersigned by the Director of Public Works and deposited in the public office of the said Minister.

4. The cost of carrying out the said work (exclusive of <sup>Estimated</sup> land resumptions) is estimated at one hundred and seventy-<sup>cost.</sup> five thousand pounds and such estimated cost shall not, under any circumstances, be exceeded by more than ten per centum.

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SCHEDULE.

Sec. 2.

Works for the Evans Head Harbour comprising:—

1. The construction of a breakwater on the southern side of the Evans River entrance extending in a north-easterly direction a distance of approximately six hundred and fifty feet from the existing foreshore.
2. The construction of a breakwater on the northern side of the Evans River entrance extending in a north-easterly direction a distance of approximately eight hundred and fifty feet from the existing foreshore.
3. The construction of a training wall on the northern side of the Evans River for a length of approximately eight hundred and sixty feet.
4. Other associated works as may be deemed necessary or desirable by the constructing authority.

The whole of the works hereinbefore described to be subject to such modifications as may be deemed necessary or desirable by the constructing authority.
