

MUSEUM OF APPLIED ARTS AND SCIENCES ACT.

Act No. 30, 1961.

Elizabeth II, No. 30, 1961 An Act to change the name of the Museum of Technology and Applied Science; to amend the Museum of Technology and Applied Science Act, 1945; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 13th October, 1961.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Museum of Applied Arts and Sciences Act, 1961".
- Amendment of Act No. 31, 1945. **2.** (1) The Museum of Technology and Applied Science Act, 1945, is amended—
- Long title. (a) by omitting from the long title the words "Technology and Applied Science" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Applied Arts and Sciences";
- Sec. 1.
(Short title and commencement.) (b) by omitting from subsection one of section one the words "Technology and Applied Science" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Applied Arts and Sciences";
- Sec. 2.
(Definitions.) (c) by omitting from section two the words "Technology and Applied Science" wherever occurring and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Applied Arts and Sciences";
- Sec. 3.
(Trustees.) (d) by omitting from subsection three of section three the words "Technology and Applied Science" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "Applied Arts and Sciences";

(e) by omitting paragraph (c) of subsection one of section five and by inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph :—

(Vacancies—how caused.)

(c) becomes a mentally ill person, a protected person or an incapable person within the meaning of the Mental Health Act, 1958, as amended by subsequent Acts;

(f) by omitting subsection three of section twelve and by inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection :—

(Power to accept gifts, etc.)

(3) Nothing contained in the Stamp Duties Act, 1920, or in any Act amending that Act, whether passed before or after the commencement of the Museum of Applied Arts and Sciences Act, 1961, shall apply to any real or personal property of any nature or kind whatsoever comprised in any gift, bequest or devise made or to be made to the Museum or the trustees.

(g) by omitting from section fifteen the word “Colonial” wherever occurring;

(h) by omitting from subsection three of section eighteen the words “or police”.

(Regulations.)

(2) The Museum of Technology and Applied Science Act, 1945, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Museum of Applied Arts and Sciences Act, 1945-1961.

Citation.

3. Where in any Act, by-law, regulation, ordinance or any other instrument or document whatsoever of the same or a different kind or nature a reference is made to the Museum of Technology and Applied Science, such reference shall be read and construed as a reference to the Museum of Applied Arts and Sciences.

Construction of references to Museum of Technology and Applied Science.

4. (1) Nothing contained in paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) of subsection one of section two of this Act shall prejudice or affect in any way the continuity of the body corporate constituted by section three of the Museum of Technology and Applied Science Act, 1945, but the same shall continue notwithstanding the provisions of this Act.

(2) The alteration of name of the body corporate effected by this Act shall not affect any property, powers, rights, authorities, duties, functions, liabilities or obligations of the said body corporate or render defective any legal or other proceedings instituted or to be instituted by or against the said body corporate.

Any legal or other proceedings that might, but for this Act, have been continued or commenced by or against the said body corporate by the name of The Trustees of the Museum of Technology and Applied Science, may be continued or commenced by or against the said body corporate by the name of The Trustees of the Museum of Applied Arts and Sciences.
