## RACING (AMENDMENT) ACT.

## Act No. 51, 1963.

Elizabeth II, An Act to make certain provisions with respect to racemeetings conducted at the Penrith Showground;
for this purpose to amend the Finance (Taxation)
Act, 1915-1951, the Totalizator Act, 1916-1957,
and the Bookmakers (Taxation) Act, 1917-1952;
and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented
to, 13th December, 1963.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

## Short title and citation.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Racing (Amendment) Act, 1963".
- (2) The Finance (Taxation) Act, 1915, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Finance (Taxation) Act, 1915-1963.
- (3) The Totalizator Act, 1916, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Totalizator Act, 1916-1963.

- (4) The Bookmakers (Taxation) Act, 1917, as No. 51, 1963 amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Bookmakers (Taxation) Act, 1917-1963.
- 2. (1) The Finance (Taxation) Act, 1915, as amended Amendment by subsequent Acts, is amended by inserting in subsection two of Act No. 57, 1915. of section six after the words "Hawkesbury Race-course" the Sec. 6. words "and the Penrith Showground".
