CROWN EMPLOYEES APPEAL BOARD (FURTHER AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 57, 1964.

An Act to increase the salary limitation in respect Elizabeth II, of appeals to the Crown Employees Appeal

Board in promotions cases; for this purpose to amend the Crown Employees Appeal Board Act, 1944–1964; and for purposes connected therewith.

[Assented to, 16th December, 1964.]

B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Crown Employees Short title Appeal Board (Further Amendment) Act, 1964".
- (2) The Crown Employees Appeal Board Act, 1944, as amended by subsequent Acts, by the Governor pursuant to section two of the said Act and by this Act, may be cited as the Crown Employees Appeal Board Act, 1944-1964.
- 2. The Crown Employees Appeal Board Act, 1944-1964, Amendment is amended by omitting from subsection one of section ten of Act No. 15, 1944. the words "two thousand nine hundred pounds" and by Sec. 10. inserting in lieu thereof the words "three thousand five (Appeals hundred pounds".
