

**GOVERNMENT GUARANTEES (AMENDMENT)
ACT.**

Act No. 61, 1964.

Elizabeth II, An Act to make certain provisions with respect to
No. 61, 1964 the issue of government guarantees for the
repayment of loans to permanent building
societies; for this purpose to amend the
Government Guarantees Act, 1934–1948; and
for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to,
16th December, 1964.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 61, 1964
 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
 Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in
 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
 follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Government Short title
 Guarantees (Amendment) Act, 1964". and citation.

(2) The Government Guarantees Act, 1934, as
 amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as
 the Government Guarantees Act, 1934-1964.

2. The Government Guarantees Act, 1934, as amended Amendment
