

**POLICE REGULATION (SUPERANNUATION)
FURTHER AMENDMENT ACT.**

Act No. 18, 1966.

**Elizabeth II,
No. 18, 1966** An Act to provide annual superannuation allowances for widows of certain retired members of the Police Force; for this purpose to amend the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 12th April, 1966.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows : —

**Short title

citation.** 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Regulation (Superannuation) Further Amendment Act, 1966".

(2) The Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906-1966.

2. The Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906, No. 18, 1966 as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended—

(a) by inserting in section eleven after the word “Act” where secondly occurring the words “and before the commencement of the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Further Amendment Act, 1966”;

(b) by inserting next after section eleven the following new section :—

11A. (1) Subject to subsection two of this section, where—

to widow.

(a) a member of the police force to whom a superannuation allowance has been granted dies after the commencement of the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Further Amendment Act, 1966;

(b) that member was married at the date of his death; and

(c) his widow was his wife at the date of his retirement (whether by disablement or otherwise),

there shall be paid to his widow such sum by way of superannuation allowance as is equivalent to one-half of the superannuation allowance received by, or payable to, such member.

(2) A superannuation allowance under subsection one of this section—

(a) shall not be payable to a widow to whom a superannuation allowance is payable under section twelve of this Act; and

(b) shall cease and determine if the widow remarries.
