An Act to increase certain penalties under the Police Offences Act, 1901, the Vagrancy Act, 1902, and the Crimes Act 1900, as amended by subsequent Acts; for this and other purposes to amend those Acts, as so amended; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 23rd March, 1967.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows : ---

Short title and citation. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Offences, Vagrancy and Crimes (Amendment) Act, 1967".
