An Act to make provision with respect to the furnishing of information as to the cause of death of a deceased person to relatives and other persons; for this purpose to amend the Coroners Act, 1960, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 30th October, 1967.]

BE

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 52, 1967 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Coroners (Amend-Short title and citation.
- (2) The Coroners Act, 1960, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Coroners Act, 1960–1967.
- 2. The Coroners Act, 1960, as amended by subsequent Amendment of Act No. Acts, is amended by inserting next after section thirty-three the of Act No. following new section:—

33A. A coroner, justice or justices to whom a report Copies of in writing referred to in section thirty-three of this Act reports. is furnished shall, on the request in writing of a relative of the deceased person or of any person who has, in the opinion of the coroner, justice or justices, as the case may be, a sufficient interest in the cause of death of the deceased person, furnish a copy of that report to the relative or other person making the request.

In this section "relative" has the meaning ascribed thereto in paragraph (c) of subsection two of section eleven of this Act.
