Act No. 71, 1967.

An Act to provide that officers of the Public Service, the Water Conservation and Irrigation Commission, the Departments of Main Roads, Railways, Government Transport and Motor Transport, and members of the Police Force shall be entitled to long service leave upon completion of ten years service; for this purpose to amend the Public Service (Amendment) Act, 1919, the Irrigation Act, 1912, the Main Roads Act, 1924, the Government Railways Act, 1912, the Transport Act, 1930, and the Police Regulation Act, 1899, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 7th December, 1967.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 71, 1967 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Service and Citation. Other Statutory Bodies (Extended Leave) Amendment Act, 1967."
