Act No. 94, 1967.

An Act to make further provision with respect to the proclamation of survey areas; for this and other purposes to amend the Survey Co-ordination Act, 1949, as amended by the Decimal Currency Act, 1965; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 18th December, 1967.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Survey Co-ordination (Amendment) Act, 1967".

Amendment of Act No. 27, 1949. 2. The Survey Co-ordination Act, 1949, as amended by the Decimal Currency Act, 1965, is amended—

(Surveys for the establishment of permanent survey marks in certain areas.)

(a) (i) by inserting next after subsection one of section eleven the following new subsection :—

(1A) Where the approval of the Minister has been given under subsection one of this section with respect to any area, the Surveyor-General may, for the purposes of that subsection, cause to be placed in that area such permanent marks as he thinks fit.

(ii) by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection two of the same section after the word "marks" the words "placed or adopted under this Act, or";

(General power to Surveyor-General to carry out surveys for the purposes of this Act.)

(b) by omitting from section thirteen the word "establish" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "place or establish".
