**Act No. 60, 1968.**

An Act to make further provision with respect to Ministers of the Crown; to amend the Constitution Act, 1902, and the Parliamentary Allowances and Salaries Act, 1956, as subsequently amended; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 16th December, 1968.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Constitution (Amendment) Act, 1968".

*Constitution (Amendment).*

**2.** The Constitution Act, 1902, as subsequently amended, No. 60, 1968 is amended—

- (a) by inserting in paragraph (a) of section 17H after the word “hereto” the words “or any office of profit under the Crown created by Act of Parliament as an office of the Executive Government”; Amendment of Act No. 32, 1902. Sec. 17H. (Exceptions.)
- (b) by inserting in paragraph (a) of subsection one of section twenty-nine after the word “hereto” the words “or any office of profit under the Crown created by Act of Parliament as an office of the Executive Government”; Sec. 29. (Exceptions.)
- (c) by omitting from the Second Schedule the word “Thirteen” and by inserting in lieu thereof the word “Fifteen”. Second Schedule.

**3.** The Parliamentary Allowances and Salaries Act, 1956, as subsequently amended, is amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of section four the word “thirteen” and by inserting in lieu thereof the word “fifteen”. Amendment of Act No. 22, 1956. Sec. 4. (Salaries and allowances to holders of offices in Second Schedule to Constitution Act, 1902, and Vice-President of Executive Council.)
