**Act No. 14, 1969.**

An Act to amend section 26 (2) of the Surveyors Act, 1929–1968; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 26th March, 1969.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Surveyors (Amendment) Act, 1969".

(2) The Surveyors Act, 1929, as subsequently amended and as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Surveyors Act, 1929–1969.

Amendment of Act No. 3, 1929. Sec. 26. (Taxation of bill.)

**2.** The Surveyors Act, 1929–1968, is amended by omitting from subsection two of section twenty-six the words "and approved by the Governor".
