Act No. 49, 1971.

An Act to increase the subsidy payable to councils under section thirteen of the Library Act, 1939; for this purpose to amend that Act; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th December, 1971.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Library (Amendment) Act, 1971".

2. The Library Act, 1939, is amended—

(a) by omitting from paragraph (b) of subsection four of section thirteen the words “forty-five cents” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “the prescribed amount”;

(b) by inserting next after the same subsection the following new subsection :—

(5) In subsection four of this section, “the prescribed amount” means—

(a) in respect of the year commencing on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two — fifty cents;

(b) in respect of the year commencing on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three — fifty-five cents; and

(c) in respect of the year commencing on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and every subsequent year commencing on the first day of January — sixty cents.
