Act No. 44, 1976.

An Act to repeal section 4 of the Youth and Community Services Act, 1973. [Assented to, 18th October, 1976.]

BE

Youth and Community Services (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Youth and Community Services (Amendment) Act, 1976". Short title.

2. The Youth and Community Services Act, 1973, is amended by omitting section 4. Amendment of Act No. 90, 1973. Sec. 4. (Change of title.)

3. Notwithstanding section 2, but subject to section 4, the Department of Youth and Community Services shall continue to exist under the management and control of the Minister administering the Child Welfare Act, 1939. Continuance of Department of Youth and Community Services.

4. Nothing in this Act affects any power to establish or abolish, or change the title of, any Department of the Government. Certain powers not affected.
