 B^{E} it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Meat Industry (Amendment) Act, 1977".

After "the same", insert ", either on its own behalf or".

(b) Section 14 (1) (4)---

After section 14 (1) (3), insert :----(4) purchase animals or meat;

(c) Section 14 (1) (5)—

After "meat", insert ", either on its own behalf or".

(d) Section 14 (1) (6)-

Omit "on behalf of any person, and sell the same in any place", insert instead ", either on its own behalf or on behalf of any other person, and sell the same in any place, either on its own behalf or".

(e) Section 14 (1) (8)-

After "disposal of", insert "meat,".

(f) Section 14 (1) (8)—

Omit "convert it into a merchantable article and sell the same", insert instead "sell any resulting product".

(g) Section 14 (1A)—

After section 14 (1), insert :---

(1A) In subsection (1), "meat" includes a meat product such as is used for human consumption.

(2) Section 30 (1) (5)—

After "manufacturing process to any", insert "meat,".
