Act No. 123, 1978.

An Act to amend section 7 of the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act, 1942, with respect to the penalty for offences relating to the use of uninsured motor vehicles. [Assented to, 21st December, 1978.]

Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Amendment Act, 1978".

2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commencement.

(2) Section 3 shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act, 1978.

3. The Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act, 1942, is amended— Amendment of Act No. 15, 1942.

(a) by omitting from section 7 (1) the words "two hundred dollars or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding twelve months or to both such penalty and imprisonment" and by inserting instead the words "five hundred dollars"; Sec. 7. (Uninsured motor vehicle not to be driven on a public street.)

(b) by omitting section 7 (2) and (3).
