Act No. 18, 1978.

An Act to repeal certain provisions of the Navigation Act, 1901, that relate to the discharge of lading from vessels as a consequence of amendments made to the Maritime Services Act, 1935, by the Maritime Services (Amendment) Act, 1978. [Assented to, 16th March, 1978.]

Navigation (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Navigation (Amendment) Act, 1978".

Amendment of Act No. 60, 1901.

2. The Navigation Act, 1901, is amended—

Sec. 1. (Short title.)

(a) by omitting from section 1 the matter relating to Division 3 of Part VIII;

Sec. 133. (Interpretation of terms used in this Part.) (b) by omitting from section 133 the definitions of "discharge", "lading" and "public place";

Division 3 of Part VIII.

(c) by omitting Division 3 of Part VIII.
