An Act to amend the Notice of Action and Other Privileges Abolition Act, 1977, to remove provisions in the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Act, 1942, relating to the giving of notice of action. [Assented to, 3rd April, 1978.]

Notice of Action and Other Privileges Abolition (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Notice of Action and Other Short title. Privileges Abolition (Amendment) Act, 1978".
- 2. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 19th Commence-August, 1977.

Where the date of the occurrence out of which any such claim arises is not earlier than three months after the commencement of the Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act, 1951, no action to enforce such claim shall lie against the nominal defendant unless notice of intention to make a claim is given by the claimant to the nominal defendant—

(a) in the case of an action for the recovery of any amount referred to in subsection (1) of section 26 of the Act—within the time prescribed by subsection (2) of that section;

(b) in any other case—within a period of three months after the occurrence out of which the claim arose, or within such further period as the nominal defendant or the court, upon sufficient cause being shown, may allow.
