Act No. 140, 1979.

An Act to provide that the Council of the City of Newcastle may, under the Local Government Act, 1919, lease certain land and to repeal the Borough of Newcastle Leasing and Improving Act of 1881 and the Newcastle Market Reserve Act, 1914. [Assented to, 28th November, 1979.]

Newcastle (Miscellaneous Lands).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the "Newcastle (Miscellaneous Lands) Act, 1979".

Commence— 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

- (2) Section 4 shall be deemed to have commenced on 19th June, 1979.
- Repeals. 3. The Acts specified in Schedule 1 are repealed.

Power to lease certain land. **4.** Without limiting the application of the Local Government Act, 1919, to or in respect of any land of the Council of the City of Newcastle, section 519 of that Act applies to and in respect of the land which is described in Schedule 2 and which, for the time being, is vested in or belongs to that Council.
