Act No. 6, 1979.

An Act to amend section 19 of the Parliamentary Contributory Superannuation Act, 1971; and to clarify the pension entitlement of certain persons who ceased to be members of the Legislative Council on its reconstitution. [Assented to, 10th April, 1979.]

## Parliamentary Contributory Superannuation (Constitution) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Contributory Superannuation (Constitution) Amendment Act, 1979".
- Commencement.
- 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 6th November, 1978.

Amendment of Act No. 53, 1971. Sec. 19. (Members' superannuation benefit.)

- The Parliamentary Contributory Superannuation Act, 1971, is amended by omitting from section 19 (8) the matter "section 19 or 34" and by inserting instead the matter "section 13A".
- Pension entitlement of certain ceased to be members on reconstitution of Legislative Council.
- 4. A person who ceased to be a member of the Legislative Council by reason of the operation of section 17 (1) of the persons who Constitution Act, 1902, shall, for the purposes of section 19 (1) (b) of the Parliamentary Contributory Superannuation Act, 1971, be deemed to have ceased to be a member of the Legislative Council by reason of the dissolution of Parliament next preceding his so ceasing to be such a member.
