Act No. 65, 1979.

An Act to amend section 80 of the Supreme Court Act, 1970, consequentially upon the enactment of the Public Assemblies Act, 1979. [Assented to, 11th May, 1979.]

Supreme Court (Public Assemblies) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court (Public Assemblies) Amendment Act, 1979".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Public Assemblies Act, 1979.

Amendment of Act No. 52, 1970.

3. The Supreme Court Act, 1970, is amended—

Sec. 80. (Business in the absence of the public.)

- (a) by omitting from section 80 (f) the word "or" where lastly occurring;
- (b) by inserting after section 80 (f) the following paragraph:—
 - (f1) in proceedings on an application under section 6 (1) or 7 of the Public Assemblies Act, 1979; or
