An Act to amend the Inclosed Lands Protection Act, 1901, con-  
sequentially upon the enactment of the Summary Offences  
(Repeal) Act, 1979. [Assented to, 11th May, 1979.]

*Inclosed Lands Protection (Summary Offences) Amendment.*

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title.      **1.** This Act may be cited as the "Inclosed Lands Protection (Summary Offences) Amendment Act, 1979".
