An Act to amend the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, consequent on and in connection with the enactment of the Public Service Act, 1979. [Assented to, 16th May, 1979.]

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Public Service) Amendment Act, 1979". Short title.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act. Commencement.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Public Service Act, 1979.

3. The Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, is referred to in this Act as the Principal Act. Principal Act.

4. The Principal Act is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1. Amendment of Act No. 4, 1976.

After "3", insert "to this Act or Schedule 1 to the Public Service Act, 1979".

## (2) Section 7 (2)—

Omit “this Act”, insert instead “this or any other Act”.

## (3) Section 16 (7)—

After section 16 (6), insert :—

(7) A reference in this section to an office specified in Schedule 2 includes a reference to an office specified in Schedule 1 to the Public Service Act, 1979.

## (4) (a) Schedule 1—

Omit “Deputy Chairman of the Public Service Board.”.

## (b) Schedule 1—

Omit “and Deputy Chairman”.
