Act No. 115, 1980.

An Act to amend the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906, with respect to additional superannuation allowances payable to certain widows. [Assented to, 22nd October, 1980.]

## Police Regulation (Superannuation) Amendment.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Police Regulation (Superannuation) Amendment Act, 1980".

Commencement.

- **2.** (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 28th September, 1979.

- (d) by inserting after clause 6 (2) in Schedule 1 the Sch. 1. following subclause: allowances.)
  - (3) In the application of this clause to the increase of a superannuation allowance on 20th June, 1980, any additional annual amount payable pursuant to clause 2 of Schedule 2 shall not be deemed to be part of the superannuation allowance for the purposes of determining that increase.

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN WIDOWS.

1. The payment, in respect of the period between 7th Validation January, 1972, and 27th September, 1979, of an additional of annual amount of \$390 (and any increase thereof purporting additional to have been made under this Act or any Act amending this to Act) with a superannuation allowance granted pursuant to certain section 12 to the widow of a member of the police force who widows. died before 1st July, 1971, is hereby validated.

2. (1) The additional annual amount payable with a Increase superannuation allowance granted pursuant to section 12 to in the widow of a member of the police force who died before additional 1st July, 1971, shall, on and from 28th September, 1979, be payments to increased to \$1,092.

(2) An additional annual amount referred to in subclause (1) shall, for the purposes of this Act, be deemed to be part of the annual superannuation allowance granted pursuant to section 12.

Conversion to lump sum of additional payments to certain widows.

- 3. (1) The liability of the Fund in respect of any additional annual amount referred to in clause 2 may, if the widow to whom it is payable has so elected by notice in writing served on the Board before 1st April, 1980, be redeemed either in whole or in part by the payment from the Fund of a lump sum calculated on the basis of \$250 for each \$26 per annum of the additional annual amount that the widow elects to redeem.
- (2) Subclause (1) does not apply to an additional annual amount that is payable to a widow whose husband died as a result of a motor vehicle accident and who recovered damages in respect of his death.
