Act No. 158, 1980.

An Act to amend the Motor Traffic Act, 1909, to enable the Governor to make regulations in relation to certain records kept by the Commissioner for Motor Transport, and for other purposes. [Assented to, 15th December, 1980.]

Motor Traffic (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act, 1980". Short title.

2. The Motor Traffic Act, 1909, is amended— Amendment of Act No. 5, 1909.

(a) by inserting after section 1 the following section :— Sec. 1A.

1A. This Act is divided as follows :— Arrange-ment.

PART II.—REGULATIONS—ss. 3, 3A.

(b) by inserting after section 3 (1) (q12) the following paragraph :— Sec. 3. (Regulations.)

(q13) provide for the issue of certificates relating to the records that the Commissioner is required by section 12 (1) to keep;
