Act No. 42, 1980.

An Act to amend section 20 of the Industrial Arbitration Act, 1940, consequent on the enactment of the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal Act, 1980. [Assented to, 28th April, 1980.]

#### Industrial Arbitration (Appeal Tribunal) Amendment.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short itle.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Industrial Arbitration (Appeal Tribunal) Amendment Act, 1980".

#### Commencement.

- **2.** (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal Act, 1980.

Amendment of Act No. 2, 1940. Sec. 20. (Original jurisdiction).

- **3.** The Industrial Arbitration Act, 1940, is amended by omitting section 20 (1D) (a) and (b) and by inserting instead the following paragraph:—
  - (a) is inconsistent with the operation of the provisions of Part III of the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal Act, 1980;
