An Act to amend section 48 of the Supreme Court Act, 1970, consequent on the enactment of the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal Act, 1980. [Assented to, 28th April, 1980.]

Supreme Court (Appeal Tribunal) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court (Appeal Tribunal) Amendment Act, 1980".

Commencement,

- 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal Act, 1980.

- 3. The Supreme Court Act, 1970, is amended by omitting paragraph (iii) of the definition of "specified tribunal" in section 48 (1) (a) and by inserting instead the following paragraph:—
 - (iii) the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal or a member of the Tribunal who is the Senior Chairman, the Acting Senior Chairman or a Chairman of the Tribunal;
