Act No. 103, 1982.

An Act to amend the Public Hospitals Act, 1929, in relation to the closure and amalgamation of incorporated hospitals and certain other bodies.

[Assented to, 27th October, 1982.]

Public Hospitals (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Hospitals (Amendment) Act, 1982".

Amendment of Act No. 8, 1929.

2. The Public Hospitals Act, 1929, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

AMENDMENTS TO THE PUBLIC HOSPITALS ACT, 1929.

(1) (a) Section 13 (1) (a)—

Omit the paragraph.

(b) Section 13 (1) (b)—

Omit the paragraph, insert instead:—

(b) limit or extend the activities of any incorporated hospital;

(c) Section 13 (2)—

Omit the subsection.

AMENDMENTS TO THE PUBLIC HOSPITALS ACT, 1929—*continued.*

(2) Section 13A—

After section 13, insert:—

Closure or amalgamation of hospitals.

13A. (1) Where the Minister is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to—

- (a) close any incorporated hospital; or
- (b) amalgamate any 2 or more incorporated hospitals,

he may recommend to the Governor that the hospital be closed or the hospitals be amalgamated, as the case may be.

(2) The Governor may, in accordance with a recommendation made under this section, by order published in the Gazette—

- (a) close an incorporated hospital; or
- (b) amalgamate 2 or more incorporated hospitals.

(3) A closure or an amalgamation shall be effected under this section without the holding of an inquiry.

(3) Section 29i (2)—
