**An Act to amend the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975,
consequentially upon the enactment of the Public Authorities Super-
annuation Board Act, 1983. [Assented to, 28th November, 1983.]**

*Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Public Authorities Superannuation Board)
Amendment.*

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Public Authorities Superannuation Board) Amendment Act, 1983".

Commencement.

2. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Section 3 (2) shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Public Authorities Superannuation Board Act, 1983.

Amendment of Act No. 4, 1976.

3. (1) The Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, is amended by inserting in Part 1 of Schedule 2 after the words "President of the Local Government Superannuation Board." the following words:—

President of the Public Authorities Superannuation Board.

Vice-President of the Public Authorities Superannuation Board.

(2) The Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, is further amended—

(a) by omitting from Part 1 of Schedule 2 the following words:—

President of the Local Government Superannuation Board.

- (b) (i) by omitting from Part 1 of Schedule 3 the matter in Columns 1 and 2 relating to a Chairman of the New South Wales Retirement Board;
