Act No. 144, 1983.

An Act to amend the Theatres and Public Halls Act, 1908, as a consequence of the repeal of the Sunday Entertainment Act, 1966, and to remove the prohibition against the holding of a public entertainment or public meeting on Christmas Day or Good Friday. [Assented to, 22nd December, 1983.]

Theatres and Public Halls (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Theatres and Public Halls (Amendment) Act, 1983".

2. The Theatres and Public Halls Act, 1908, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.
