Act No. 23, 1984.

An Act to amend the Bills of Sale Act of 1898 with respect to the days on which bills of sale may be lodged, filed or recorded in the office of the Registrar-General. [Assented to, 6th June, 1984.]

Bills of Sale (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Bills of Sale (Amendment) Act, 1984".

Amendment of Act No. 10, 1898.

2. The Bills of Sale Act of 1898 is amended by omitting from section 16 the words "a public or a bank holiday" and by inserting instead the words "a public holiday or a prescribed day".
