Act No. 106, 1985.

An Act to amend section 1001 of the Justices Act, 1902, so as to enable the enforcement, under Part IVB of that Act, of penalty notices served under the Motor Dealers Act, 1974. [Assented to, 21st June, 1985.]

### Justices (Motor Dealers) Amendment 1985

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

#### Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Justices (Motor Dealers) Amendment Act, 1985".

## Commencement.

- 2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor in respect thereof and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

## Amendment of Act No. 27, 1902.

3. The Justices Act, 1902, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.
