Act No. 110, 1985

An Act to repeal the Constitutional Powers (New South Wales) Act 1978 and to annul the Privy Council Appeals Abolition Bill 1979. [Assented to, 27th September, 1985.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Constitutional Legislation (Repeal) Act 1985".

Repeal of Act No. 130, 1978

2. The Constitutional Powers (New South Wales) Act 1978 is repealed.

Annulment of Privy Council Appeals Abolition Bill 1979

3. The passage of the Privy Council Appeals Abolition Bill 1979 through the Legislative Assembly and the Legislative Council of New South Wales during the forty-sixth Parliament is annulled and the Bill has no force or effect.
