An Act to amend the Fisheries and Oyster Farms Act 1935 in relation to
noxious fish. [Assented to 29th November, 1985.]

Fisheries and Oyster Farms (Noxious Fish) Amendment 1985

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Fisheries and Oyster Farms (Noxious Fish) Amendment Act 1985".

Amendment of Act No. 58, 1935

2. The Fisheries and Oyster Farms Act 1935 is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

AMENDMENTS TO THE FISHERIES AND OYSTER FARMS ACT 1935

(1) Section 20B (2)—

At the end of section 20B, insert:

(2) In this Division, a reference to live fish, in relation to oysters, is a reference to live oysters within their shells and to live spat.

(2) (a) Section 20C (1A)—

After section 20C (1), insert:

(1A) The Governor may, by order published in the Gazette, declare that oysters commonly known as Pacific oysters are noxious fish for the purposes of this Division if they are in—

(a) any waters;

(b) any specified class of waters; or

(c) any waters other than waters of a specified class.

(b) Section 20c (2)—

After “subsection (1)”, insert “or (1A)”.
