Act No. 211, 1985

An Act to amend the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act 1906 in relation to the retirement of certain members of the Police Force.
[Assented to, 10th December, 1985.]

Police Regulation (Superannuation) Amendment 1985

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Police Regulation (Superannuation) Amendment Act 1985".

Commencement

2. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Schedule 1 (1) and section 3 in its application to that provision shall be deemed to have commenced on 23 November 1984.

Amendment of Act No. 28, 1906

3. The Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act 1906 is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

AMENDMENTS TO THE POLICE REGULATION
(SUPERANNUATION) ACT 1906

(1) Section 7 (**Superannuation allowance except where member hurt on duty**)—

Section 7 (1) (b)—

Omit "one-twelfth", insert instead "in the case of a person who has completed less than 30 years of service, one-twelfth".

(2) Section 7AA (**Superannuation allowance on early retirement**)—

(a) Section 7AA (1)—

Omit the subsection, insert instead:

(1) In this section—

“commissioned rank” means any rank of or above that of inspector, but does not include a prescribed rank;

“salary of office”, in relation to a member of the police force, means—

(a) except as provided by paragraph (b)—the member’s salary of office at the date of retirement; or

(b) where—

(i) the member was promoted to a rank (other than a commissioned rank) within the period of 1 year before the date of retirement (but is not a person to whom subparagraph (iii) applies);

(ii) the member was promoted to a commissioned rank within the period of 2 years before the date of retirement (but is not a person to whom subparagraph (iii) applies); or

(iii) the member was promoted to a rank (other than a commissioned rank) and to a commissioned rank within the period of 1 year before the date of retirement,

the salary of office the member would have received at the date of retirement if the member had not been so promoted.

(b) Section 7AA (3) (a)—

Omit “, a Deputy Commissioner or an Assistant Commissioner”.
